Maintenance and product information, please read carefully

Congratulations on your table purchase!

Our tables are made of wild oak. This can be recognized by the rough drawing that appears in the wood. There are cracks and knots and the thickness of the table can be irregular. It's a beautiful natural product.

The production process of our tables is pure manual labour and old craftsmanship. Any differences in color or other imperfections are a result of nature. Because of our production process each table is unique.

On the surface of the table there are multiple layers of wood-stain and lacquer. All our tables are finished with a strong lacquer of two components. All surface products we use are free of harmful metals and comply with DIN 68861.1/1B and EN71/3 'safety standards for children's toys'.

The ideal inside climate for us humans is not too dry and especially not too hot. It's exactly this climate which is best for wooden furniture. Ideal is when the temperature is around 20 degrees Celsius and the humidity is between 45% and 55%. When the table is exposed to an extreme deviation of these conditions for a long period of time, the wood can crack and/or bend. There are different ways increase to humidity, for example by putting plants in the room or by using a humidifier.

Never put the furniture directly next to the heating system and/or other heat sources. This way you can avoid the wood to crack and bend.

Stains caused by tea, coffee, wine, water, chocolate etcetera should be removed immediately using a lightly moist cloth. This will prevent the penetration of contaminated color pigments in the pores of the wood's surface. After removing the stains with the lightly moist cloth, the table should be dried using a soft cloth.

We recommend you use table mats and coasters made of cork or felt under pans, mugs, coffee pots, etc. to prevent damage caused by spills. Do not use table mats or coasters made of plastic, rubber or similar materials that contain plasticizers as this may attack the finish (or lacquer).

Maintenance

There are several products available for the maintenance. Please contact your local supplier for advise about which product is best used on the solid oak tables which are finished with a mat lacquer.

This way your table top will be fresh, clean and maintained.

CAUTION:

Absolutely avoid the following:

- Stain removers
- Abrasives
- Solvents
- Turpentine
- Chlorine
- Plasticizers
- Scented cleaning solutions
- Caustics
